#### **Project Overview**

The City of Concordia seeks funding from the US Department of Transportation (USDOT), Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for funding available through the Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG) to complete construction of a box hangar, installation of associated utilities, pavement marking, and erosion control measures at Blosser Municipal Airport.

AIG is a formula BIL program that has a local match requirement of 10%. The City is requesting \$12,555 from the Build Kansas Fund. This request unlocks \$113,000 in federal funds. AIG can be used to invest in runways, taxiways, safety, terminal, airport-transit connections, and roadway projects.

Applications are due on April 1, 2025. The Build Kansas Fund application was received on December 17, 2023.

#### **Build Kansas Fund Steering Committee Recommendation**

Briefly describe your efforts to find other available funding sources for this project:

The City prepares a Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) each year and forecasts several years into the future. All CIP funds currently available have been allocated for other necessary projects. ARPA funds awarded to the City have been spent or allocated on projects currently underway. Local grants do not fund projects of this scope. The City's General Fund is needed and used for operations and maintenance of existing infrastructure. and therefore is not used for improvements. Furthermore, while the City has a healthy Reserve Fund, our auditor has advised us to maintain at least three months' of expenses in this fund in the event of an emergency: drawdown for this project would put us below that amount. The City is also currently acting as the fiscal agent for a large grant for our local Housing Authority, and are awaiting reimbursement from the grant, which has applied pressure to our reserve fund. The City is required to abide by Kansas Cash Basis Law, meaning we must have the cash available in order to spend it.

#### Brief narrative on the scope of work

The proposed project for the City of Concordia at the Blosser Municipal Airport (CNK) will involve the design and construction of a new  $80' \times 80'$  box hangar south of the existing terminal ramp and east of the existing taxilanes. The base bid of the design will include the building, one  $70' \times 20'$  aviation door on the west side and three pedestrian doors (two on the north side of the building and one on the south), and the concrete for the relocated taxilane centerline and building approach on the west side of the building.

The project will include construction of approximately 943 SY of concrete pavement to connect the new hangar to the existing taxilane. The proposed site layout is attached and included with this document.

The major improvements include the following:

- 1. Construct new 80' x 80' Box Hangar with single aviation door. Construct approximately 943 S.Y. of new concrete pavement for drive and sidewalks.
- 2. Grading of surrounding area to tie into existing features.
- 3. Install storm sewer.
- 4. Installation of utilities, as required.
- 5. Pavement marking.
- 6. Installation of temporary erosion control measures (seed, cover crop, straw wattles, silt fence) to stabilize the on-site soils and prevent soil run-off.
