

# Want to start planning for your child's education?

## Let us help you!



- Kansas Investments Developing Scholars (K.I.D.S.) Matching Grant program will match the first \$600 that participants contribute to a Learning Quest 529 Education Savings Program account each year that they are eligible.
- K.I.D.S. was developed for families with income less than 200% of the federal poverty level.
- To be eligible participants must be Kansas residents.

### Are you eligible?

Participants must be Kansas residents and total Federal Adjusted Gross Income for all members of the participant's household must be less than the amounts listed in the chart below.

#### Household of:

1 = \$21,660	4 = \$44,100
2 = \$29,140	5 = \$51,580
3 = \$36,620	6 = \$59,060

For each additional person in the family, add \$7,480.
